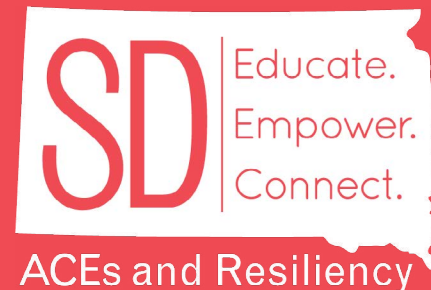


Understanding ACEs: Building Self-Healing Communities
